HALF DAY TOUR (EX. CITY)

KUCHING CITY TOUR (DURATION: 3 HOURS+-)

Includes: All guided tour, Entrance fee 1 bottle drinking water

Kuching, the Capital of Sarawak, is a cosmopolitan city and this is reflected in the faces on the street. Its city centre is well preserved with ornate Chinese Temples, The Astana, City Tower, many fine examples of colonial-style architecture, a beautiful waterfront and a number of interesting museums such as Cat Museum. Other places of interest include the famous landmark of the City, the New DUN, The Golden Bridge, The Cat Monument, Market, Main Bazaar, China Town, Old State Mosque & etc. Kuching is a good destination to shop for souvenir such as woodcarvings, "Pua Kumbu" with native design, Pepper products and Sarawak pottery. Sarawak Bird's Nest and Local Products are some of the famous souvenirs which can be found in Kuching. Note: Kek Lapis visit, is target especially for Malaysian, Bruneian and Singaporean. Visit to KEK LAPIS STORE. The Sarawak layer cake is a well-loved local delicacy that is laborious and intricate to make but so delicious to eat. These colourful cakes also make great gifts to friends.



BORNEO CULTURES MUSEUM (DURATION: 3 HOURS+-)

Includes: All guided tour, Entrance fee 1 bottle drinking water

The Borneo Cultures Museum is a modern five-storey building with a distinctive architectural design that reflects Sarawak's unique traditional crafts and rich cultural heritage.

The new museum wants to become a lively place for social and cultural exchange. The auditorium and function rooms on level one will be able to host a wide range of events, and these programmes will turn the museum into a vibrant venue. Also here, are the visitor facilities that will cater to the visitors' essential needs such as the reception counter, restaurant and shop.

Located on level two are the Children's Gallery and the Arts and Crafts Gallery. The Children's Gallery provides an optimal interactive learning environment for children through its exhibition and activities. The theme 'Love Our Rivers' focuses on the concept of sustainability using rivers as the foundation of the exhibition narrative. Activities arranged in the Arts and Crafts Gallery allows visitors to learn the skills of traditional craftsmanship, dances and music.

Level three is the biggest gallery with 2,188 square metres of exhibition space. The exhibition theme is 'In Harmony With Nature', and it explores the relationship local communities have with the natural environment based on a river journey through three major geographical regions. This exhibition offers immersive and multisensory experiences.

On level four is the 'Time Changes' exhibition that will have displays with a strong educational focus. This informative gallery will cater to school groups and topics covered in the history curriculum. Also included in, is the archaeological discoveries and findings in the State. The narrative tells the history of Sarawak dating from the prehistoric era to modern times.

Finally, the museum's masterpieces and best examples of Sarawak's material culture will be on display in level five. The 'Objects of Desire' gallery will have a strong object focus that allows visitors to admire the artistic beauty of these artefacts. The gallery will be showcasing artefacts that reflect skilled craftsmanship, having designs with divine powers and as a symbol of status.



HALF DAY TOUR (EX. CITY)

SARAWAK CULTURAL VILLAGE (DURATION: 3-4 HOURS+-)

Includes: All guided tour, Entrance fee, Cultural show performance, 1 bottle drinking water

Popularly known as the 'Living Museum', the Village is a showcase of a kaleidoscope of Sarawak's cultures and traditions. On arrival, you will explore the 7 authentic replicas of ethnic houses. Chinese Farm House, Malay's Stilted House, Melanau Tall House, Penan Hut as well as Longhouse of the Iban, Bidayuh and Orang Ulu. Displayed in each house are the many artifacts made by the individual dwellers. Demonstration of arts and crafts like beadwork, wood and bamboo carvings, "Pua" weaving and straw weaving can be seen while touring the Village. You will also be entertained with 45 minutes of the traditional dances of the various ethnic tribes of Sarawak at the Village theatre.



SEMENGGOH WILDLIFE CENTRE (DURATION: 3 HOURS+-)

Includes: All guided tour, Entrance fee, and 1 bottle drinking water

Unlike in a zoo, the Orang Utans are free to roam in this 653 hectare forest reserve. Here, young and adolescent Orang Utans are trained to survive in the wild. Spot their delicate nests; watch their skillful movements on the tree tops and their interesting behavior during feeding time. The guide will also narrate to you the behavior and characteristics of this special primate called Orang Utan or 'Man of the Forest' in the Malay language.

HALF DAY TOUR (EX. CITY)

CROCODILE FARM & MINI ZOO (DURATION: 3 HOURS+-)

Includes: All guided tour, Entrance fee, and 1 bottle drinking water

Set amidst lush greenery, the farm is home to over 1,000 salt and fresh water crocodiles. It serves as a perfect sanctuary to these fearsome reptiles kept in enclosures similar to their natural habitat. Watch the crocodiles in action during feeding time. Explore the farm to see other fascinating animals such as the bear cats, pythons, peacocks, otters and 'the world's largest fresh water fish' - the *Arapaima Gigas*.

ANNAH RAIS BIDAYUH LONGHOUSE (DURATION: 4 HOURS+-)

Includes: All guided tour, Entrance fee, and 1 bottle drinking water

Bidayuh, the second largest ethnic group in Sarawak, is formerly known as the 'Land Dayak' and was once also known as the 'Engineer of Bamboo'. When visiting the Bidayuh longhouse, you will be able to see the splendid architecture of their longhouse, which were build mostly by bamboo.

Annah Rais is one of the most famous Bidayuh longhouse in Sarawak, which located about 100 km east from Kuching City. The excursion will take about one and a half-hour on the road. During your visit, you will also be able to view the villagers with their own daily routine like rice pounding and winnowing, basket and mat weaving and bamboo carving. You will also see the most unique and important structure, the 'Baruk' or the head house, which situated in front of the longhouse. Villagers once used this as a fort to protect the whole village from being attack. Inside the 'Baruk', you will be able to view the real human skulls hanging around the fire place in the middle and the also their sacred war drum.




HALF DAY TOUR (EX. CITY)

FAIRY & WIND CAVE (DURATION: 4 HOURS+-)

Includes: All guided tour, Entrance fee, and 1 bottle drinking water

The Fairy Cave stands 3-storey high. After a quick climb, the cave opens up into a main chamber. Sunlight streams into the chamber, revealing to you the beautiful shapes of nature's creations, the stalactites and stalagmites.

The Wind Cave is a tunnel-like cave filled with bats and swiftlets. Look around the walls of the cave and see if you can spot the bird nests. It was an underground river chamber in the olden days.



KUBAH NATIONAL PARK (DURATION: 4 HOURS+-)

Includes: All guided tour, Entrance fee, and 1 bottle drinking water

It is an easy & enjoyable day trip from Kuching and is situated on a small sandstone plateau with crystal clear streams and small waterfalls. Here you can see the widest selections of palms & orchid in Borneo. The Waterfall Trail starts from the Park HQ and takes approximately 1 hr 30 mins. The trail passes through mixed dipterocarp forest and has numerous plank walk sections which cross swampy areas and small jungle streams. Wild durian trees can be seen along the sides of the trail. The waterfall consists of a number of sections with the main section dropping some 10 metres onto a wide rocky ridge. Below this ridge is a small pool that is idea for a cool jungle dip.

Item to bring : Light clothing, towel, raincoat, insect repellent, sun block, walking shoe.



HALF DAY TOUR (EX. CITY)

GUNUNG GADING NATIONAL PARK (DURATION: 5-6 HOURS+-)

Includes: All guided tour, Entrance fee, and 1 bottle drinking water

The excursion will take an hour 30 minutes by land and this is the national park where you are able to view the largest flower in the world - the Rafflesia. (Subjected to flower blooming season). It grows up to 3 feet wide. When in bloom, the flower emits an unique growing process and a foul smell, which attracts flies and other insects for pollination. Trek along the wooden planks and it will bring you through the thick Primary and Secondary Tropical Forest. Squirrels are jumping from tree to tree and if you are lucky enough, you may encounter the white-crested hornbill.

Item to bring : Light clothing, towel, raincoat, insect repellent, sun block, walking shoe.





MATANG WILDLIFE CENTRE (DURATION: 4 HOURS+-)

Includes: All guided tour, Entrance fee, and 1 bottle drinking water

The Matang Wildlife Centre is about 35km from Kuching. Located in Kubah National Park, this large enclosed area of rainforest is home to some endangered wildlife.

Matang Wildlife Centre covers 179 hectares of lowland rainforest with animals in varying stages of rehabilitation. Here, one can gain information and learn about Sarawak's wildlife.

There are various eco-tourism projects being carried out at Matang Wildlife Centre such as Heart to Heart with Orang Utan training programme where young orang utans are being taught or retrained to survive in the wild. These Orang Utans are either orphaned or rescued from captivity. Besides these adorable primates, there are also Sun Bears, Sambar Deer, Civet cats as well as three large aviaries that house Sea Eagles, Hornbills and other birds in Sarawak.



HALF DAY TOUR (EX. CITY)

MORNING DOLPHIN SPOTTING CRUISE (DURATION: 3 HOURS+)

Includes: All guided tour, Boat fee, Return transfer, and 1 bottle drinking water

This cruise criss-crosses the mouth of the Santubong River in search of the rare Irrawaddy Dolphin. The Irrawaddy, or snubfin dolphin, inhabits rivers, estuaries and shallow coastal areas. The Santubong area is one of the best places in Sarawak to view this unusual looking marine mammal. The dolphins are often seen swimming and diving around small fishing boats in the estuary. Occasionally they are seen playing in the open water. Visitors will need a keen eye to spot the dolphins at first, but after a short wait they can often be seen surfacing all around the boat. Cruises along Salak River and have a view the fishing village with houses on stilts.

EVENING WILDLIFE & NATURE WATCHING CRUISE (DURATION: 4 HOURS+)

Includes: All guided tour, Boat fee, Return transfer and 1 bottle drinking water

This tour takes you around the rivers of the Santubong Peninsular, offering you the chance of seeing some of Sarawak's fascinating wildlife. The cruise starts at the Santubong Village. From there your boat cruises to the mouth of the Santubong River, where Irrawaddy dolphins are often spotted. Your boat then roams the mangrove lined rivers looking for wildlife. As the light starts to fade we go in search of the rare proboscis monkey. Small groups are often seen on the treetops at the water's edge, settling down for the night. As dusk arrives we search for fireflies and crocodiles. Crocodiles are often seen on the mud banks and brightly shining crocodile eyes can be spotted when a torch light is passed over the river. After searching for crocodiles your boat proceeds further up river where fireflies gather at night. Watch the fireflies move around the branches of the mangroves, momentarily lighting up the night sky. After enjoying a firefly light show you return to the jetty.

HALF DAY TOUR (EX. CITY)

SATANG ISLAND EXCURSION (DURATION: 5 HOURS+ -)

Includes: Return transfer, Boat Trip, 1 packed lunch, 1 bottle drinking water & goggle provided

Excludes: Optional activities costs, Personal Expenses, Tips and gratuities

In the morning, take a boat ride to Satang Island, the island is part of the Talang – Satang National Park and is protected for the conservation of Sea turtles. Along the boat ride you may be able to catch glimpses of mudskippers foraging on the mid-banks or even tiny agile flying fish leaping across the bow of your boat. Sometimes, you might be 'Lucky' to spot some Irrawaddy dolphins. Upon arrival, visit the turtle hatchery and learn about the conservation work being done to help these endangered sea creatures. After that spend a few hours swimming and snorkeling its pristine waters, well known for its beautiful corals and colourful fish. Packed lunch is provided, after lunch transfer back to the jetty and make you way back to hotel.

SARAWAK RIVER CRUISE (DURATION: 1 1/2 HOURS) (1730 – 1900hrs)

Includes: Return transfer, Cruise fee, Light refreshment

Cruise along the Sarawak River and enjoy the enchanting Sunset and night view of various phases of the city, retracing the trip James Brooke made when he first arrived in Sarawak. Take in the sights of the Waterfront, Brooke Dockyard, the 100-year old Malay Kampung, Fort Magherita, Astana, Square Tower and the mansions of Kuching's affluent society. This living scenery gives you a snapshot of the history and lifestyles of Kuching.



HALF DAY TOUR (EX. CITY)

MEDAN NIAGA SATOK (DURATION: 1 1/2 HOURS)

Includes: Return transfer & 1 bottle drinking water

The **Medan Niaga Satok**, which actually starts on every Saturday afternoon until Sunday noon is held at Kubah Ria. It is renowned for the Bidayuh ladies who spread their jungle produce along the parking spaces. Walk around and view all the colorful and exotic vegetables arranged on the mats or canvas to attract buyers. The Stalls at the Medan Niaga Satok are divided into various categories. Visitors should not miss Pasar Satok as the busy market offers views of diverse cultures, a cacophony of unfamiliar languages (especially for those familiar with standard Malay and English) and an assortment of products. In the market, you will find a lot of exotic fruits and vegetables like wild jungle ferns – ‘Midin’, which can only be found in Sarawak. There are also ‘Snake skin’ fruits and wild ‘belimbing’. Occasionally, you might be able to see one of the unique delicacies of the ethnic group, which is high in protein and believed to be a cure for ‘asthma’; the life ‘sago’ worms which is normally fried or eat fresh as snacks during tea break. There are also Chinese and Malay stalls selling various items such as the famous fresh water salted fish, ‘ikan terubok masin’, ikan bakar, local handicrafts and ethnic carvings, fruits, vegetables, poultry, seafood, unique plants and flowers like wild orchids, wild honey, traditional herbs (used as medicine), pets and even clothing. Various types of local kuih and snacks are also on sale at the market.



HALF DAY TOUR (EX. CITY)

KUBAH BIRDING TOUR (DURATION: 4 – 5 HOURS+ -)

Includes: All guided tour, Entrance fee, Return transfer & 1 bottle drinking water

Pick up from City Hotel then proceed to Kubah National Park. The Park is situated on a sandstone plateau, mostly covered by mixed dipterocarp forest which interspersed with patches of scrub and unusually rich area of Kerangas forest, is the home of mammals, birds & many species of reptiles and amphibians. Upon arrival, aim to spot some endemic species like Blue-banded pitta, Bornean blue-flycatcher, Yellow-rumped flowerpecker, Bornean Black-magpie, Chestnut-crested yuhina, Dusky munia & etc. Meanwhile, aim to spot other resident birds like Red-bearded bee-eater, Raffles's malkoha, Red-naped trogan, Diard's trogon, Scarlet-rumped trogon, Rufous-collared kingfisher, Rufous-backed kingfisher, Banded kingfisher, White-crowned hornbill, Red-crowned barbet, Red-throated barbet, Gold-whiskered barbet, Rufous piculet, Buff-necked woodpecker, Maroon woodpecker, Black-&-yellow broadbill, Banded broadbill, Green broadbill, Scarlet minivet, Asian fairy bluebird, Blue-winged leafbird, Scaly-breasted bulbul, Grey-bellied bulbul, Chestnut-naped fork-tail, Rufous-crowned babbler, Scaly-crowned babbler, Grey-headed babbler, Brown fulvetta, Spotted fantail, Asian paradise flycatcher, Grey-breasted jungle-flycatcher, Scarlet-breasted flowerpecker, Crimson sunbird, Grey-breasted spiderhunter, Crested jay & etc. After tour, transfer back to Hotel.



EVENING FROGGING TOUR (DURATION: 4 – 5 HOURS+ -)

Includes: All guided tour, Entrance fee, Return transfer, Refreshment pack & 1 bottle drinking water

Pick up from City Hotel then proceed to Kubah National Park. The Park is situated on a sandstone plateau, mostly covered by mixed dipterocarp forest which interspersed with patches of scrub and unusually rich area of Kerangas forest, is the home of mammals, birds & many species of reptiles and amphibians.

More than 61 species of frogs has been recorded in the Park, which is 1/3 of the total species of frog in Borneo Island. Species like Lowland litter frog, Bornean horned frog, Matang Narrow-mouthed frog, Kuhl's creek frog, Giant river frog, Peat swamp frog, Mahogany frog, Spotted stream frog, File-eared tree frog, Dark-eared tree frog, Harlequin tree frog & etc are commonly found in the National Park. After tour, transfer back to Hotel.



HALF DAY TOUR (EX. CITY)

WORLD WAR II (WWII) HISTORICAL TOUR (DURATION: 3 HOURS+-)

Includes: All guided tour, Entrance fee, Return transfer & 1 bottle drinking water

Pick up from City Hotel and proceed for World War II Historic Tour. Not many people are aware that there are several places around Kuching city playing a significant role during the Second World War. The tour started by visiting the museum in the Teacher Education Institute of Malaysia, Batu Lintang Campus. Under the History Unit, the Institute started a small museum in remembrance of the sacrifices of the people of Sarawak. Among the more interesting artifacts that can be seen here include equipment used by soldiers of that era and a flag post used by the Japanese army. A monument acknowledging the sacrifices can also be seen. The visit also involved going to see the last remaining buildings from that era in the campus, that is, the barrack used by the Punjabi soldiers and an ammunition store.

The second place of visit was the Japanese cemetery. The Japanese cemetery now remain about 40 tombstones which according to Madam Kazue Sakai, the caretaker, this cemetery was started possibly at the turn of the last century, around 1902. Finally, we visited the Heroes' Memorial, located in between St. Joseph's Cathedral and Sarawak Club. There, various graves were found ranging from heroes fallen during the Japanese Occupation and Iban trackers killed in the line of duty during the Emergency. There were also the fallen heroes of the Confrontation. The most recent graves include those of the late Temenggong Datuk Kanang anak Langkau and DSP Michael anak Padel. Coincidentally, it was All Souls Day when we visited the memorial and relatives of some of the heroes buried there could be seen visiting the graves. It is very heartening to see that after so long, the descendants of the heroes have not forgotten them.

The tour concluded with the visit to the Heroes' Memorial. We were focusing on the Japanese Occupation but along the way, we also had the opportunity to learn of events beyond that, encompassing the Emergency, Confrontation and also the Sulu Invasion.



FULL DAY TOUR (EX. CITY)

BENGOH DAM & KAMPUNG STING HIKING (DURATION: 7 HOURS+ -)

Includes: All guided tour, Boat fee, 1 Lunch, Return transfer & 1 bottle drinking water

About 1 1/2 hours road journey to arrive at the Bengoh Dam. The road journey will end at the Bengoh Dam, where you can witness the beautiful Dam and the breathtaking photo of your journey start from here. Take a boat journey cross the dam. Hiking along the rainforest and crossing some beautiful bamboo bridge to Pe'an and Susung waterfall. It is amazing place to have funs and relax at the cool waterfall. Make sure you have take a lot of memorable photos and bring back to share remembrance. Lunch will be provided. After lunch, packed up and return by boat to the Dam jetty where we will be transfer back by land to Kuching.



FULL DAY TOUR (EX. CITY)

KAYAKING EXPERIENCE (DURATION: 7 HOURS+)

Includes: All guided tour, 1 Lunch, Return transfer & 1 bottle drinking water

After about 45 minutes' drive from town you are transported to the mist covered hill sides of Borneo Highlands with undulating terrain dotted by small scale pepper farms. You will alight at Bengoh, a delightful Bidayuh village and staging point for journeys by foot or rivers deep into the interiors. Here you will be given brief paddling instructions and safety briefing before proceeding down some steps to a small tributary where your parked kayaks awaits. A group photo will be taken before we embark on our kayaking adventure. This shaded stream with overhanging trees, steep banks and a bridge overhead has just enough room for your kayaks to get through and meanders a short distance before opening into the vista of Sg. Sarawak Kiri. The wider river allows easier passage and open up vistas with views of the secondary forests and the farmlands of the local villagers.

You will see small fruits plantation and cocoa trees growing on these pockets of farm land. The gentle flowing river aids the journey and soon everyone will be paddling with confidence and enjoying the scenery as well as the fresh air. Sounds of birds and insects accompanied the kayakers along the entire journey. Sights of unique limestone rock outcrop formations on the right side of the river make a wonderful photo-opportunity for all. Stop at waterfall before reaching Kg Danu where we will alight on a pebbled island under a pedestrian only suspension bridge. Stop for fish feeding then continue the journey to our finishing point. Climb up some steps then enjoy local lunch over there. (Shower, toilet and changing room is available). After lunch heading back to Kuching.



FULL DAY TOUR (EX. CITY)

BAKO NATIONAL PARK (DURATION: 7 HOURS+-)**Includes: All guided tour, Boat fee, Entrance fee, 1 Lunch, Return transfer & 1 bottle drinking water**

Bako National Park, the oldest and one of the most popular national parks in Sarawak, offers the perfect introduction to Sarawak's forest and wildlife. It contains a wide range of vegetation, jungle streams, waterfalls, interesting plant life, trekking trails and coastlines covered with small bays, coves and beaches. Visitors can see wildlife such as proboscis monkeys, long-tailed macaques, Borneo bearded pigs and monitor lizards. You will be able to experience almost desert-like scrub or 'padang' on the plateau to lowland dipterocarp forest. Erosion has left some remarkable sandstone formations such as the famous Sea Stack.



OVERNIGHT TOUR (EX. CITY)

2D1N BENGOH DAM & KAMPUNG STING ADVENTURE (DURATION: OVERNIGHT)

Includes: All guided tour, Boat fee, Longhouse Expenses, 3 Meals (B/L/D), Return transfer & 1 bottle drinking water

Day 01 ~ Pick up from city and proceed to Kampung Sting. Enjoy a land transfer for about one and half hours (depends on traffic congestion) before reaching the Bengoh Dam. Cross the Dam within 15 mins and reach our destination, It is located on a hill surrounded by the scenic view of the Bengoh Dam, Kampung Sting is a spot worth explore near Kuching. Simple lunch provided.

Start the trek to Pe'an waterfall and Curtain waterfall, estimated 30 minutes for both waterfall. Take a 15 minutes rest before continue to Susung Waterfall (another 30 minutes hike), the most beautiful waterfall and make sure you to take the perfect snap for your social media site. Make a return trip on the same route to homestay. Dinner will be served and relax the rest of the night.

Day 02 ~ Next morning, enjoy the sunrise with breakfast. Pack up and return by boat to the Dam jetty where you will be transfer back by land and approximately by noon to arrive at Kuching city.

2D1N BAKO NATIONAL PARK (DURATION: OVERNIGHT)

Day 01 ~ Pick up from City Hotel and proceed for Bako National Park Tour. Bako National Park, established since 1957, is the oldest and one of the most popular national parks in Sarawak. Situated about 37 km from Kuching City, the excursion takes about one and a half-hour by land and boat. With an area about 2,728 hectares, it offers the perfect introduction to Sarawak's forest and wildlife. Unlike the other parks, visitors to Bako National Park are almost guaranteed to see wildlife such as long-tailed macaques, squirrels, white bearded pigs, silver leaf monkeys, etc. With 17 trails provided, ranging from 0.2 km to 5.75 km, you will almost find new experience in each different trail. You will be brought along the Teluk Paku trail. To spot the Proboscis monkey, species, which only can be found in Borneo Island, you will need to walk slowly, keep as quiet as possible, and listen out for sounds and movement along the way. In Bako National Park, you will also be able to view 7 different types of vegetations and forests from almost desert-like scrub or 'padang' to lowland dipterocarp forest.

Day 02 ~ After breakfast at the Park Canteen, continue for jungle trekking to explore others flora & fauna. Lunch is provided. Later afternoon, check out from the rest house and take a boat ride back to Bako Jetty. Transfer back to Kuching.

Day 01 ~ Pick up from City Hotel and proceed for Bako National Park Tour. Bako National Park, established since 1957, is the oldest and one of the most popular national parks in Sarawak. Situated about 37 km from Kuching City, the excursion takes about one and a half-hour by land and boat. With an area about 2,728 hectares, it offers the perfect introduction to Sarawak's forest and wildlife. Unlike the other parks, visitors to Bako National Park are almost guaranteed to see wildlife such as long-tailed macaques, squirrels, white bearded pigs, silver leaf monkeys, etc. With 17 trails provided, ranging from 0.2 km to 5.75 km, you will almost find new experience in each different trail. Day 03 ~ After breakfast at the Park Canteen, continue for jungle trekking to explore others flora & fauna. Lunch is provided. Later afternoon, check out from the rest house and take a boat ride back to Bako Jetty. Transfer back to Kuching.



OVERNIGHT TOUR (EX. CITY)

2D1N IBAN LONGHOUSE SAFARI (DURATION: OVERNIGHT)

Includes: All guided tour, Boat fee, Longhouse Expenses, 4 Meals (B/2L/D), Return transfer & 1 bottle drinking water

Day 01 ~ Pick up from City Hotel and proceed for Iban Longhouse Safari. A village of 20 – 25 'bilek' or rooms (each for one family) all under one roof of a long stretch wooden house standing on stilts. The expedition will begin with a 4 hours car ride passing through the scenic greenery countryside. The vast land on both side of the road are can be seen dotted with vegetable farms, padi fields, rubber, pepper, oil palm and cocoa plantations which generated some of the top revenue earner crops of Sarawak. En route you will have a brief stopover at small native town called Serian. Experience the busy daily wet market and witness some of the rare jungle produce brought by the native from the deep jungle. Lunch break is at 'Lachau' – small popular 'cowboy' town for Indonesian natives from the nearby Kalimantan border town to do barter trade. You can do your last minutes shopping for the visiting gift to present to your Iban host. The car ride will end at a riverbank where a native longboat ride will take you upstream. The journey varies depending on the water level of the river and which longhouse; from 20 mins to nearly an hour. Poling under trees bending protectively over the river and shooting rapids (during dry season, you might be required to get down and help the boatman to drag the boat for a short distance) before arriving at your destination. Upon arrival at the longhouse, you can tour around the longhouse while the 'semi-wild' boars and hunting dogs running nearby. You can mingle with the longhouse folks & talk about their daily activities and the communal style of living at the longhouse or share your side of the story. Cool off and relax yourself in the river is one of the best thing to do after the whole long journey. After dinner, you will be led to the longhouse again. The Iban maidens and 'warriors' will perform a welcome dance while 'tuak' – the locally brewed rice wines are served as welcome drink. Overnight at Iban Longhouse's Guesthouse. Day 02 ~ After breakfast at the guesthouse, you will be invited to watch the demonstration of one of the Iban favourite gambling game – 'cock fighting' and using of the blowpipe which will be held at the open space. That is a chance for you to try on this popular leisure game and polish your skill of using the deadly weapon – 'blowpipe'. Return trip to Kuching is by longboat and overland. Transfer back to Kuching and check in to hotel.



OVERNIGHT TOUR (EX. CITY)

3D2N IBAN LONGHOUSE SAFARI (DURATION: OVERNIGHT)

Includes: All guided tour, Boat fee, Longhouse Expenses, 4 Meals (B/2L/D), Return transfer & 1 bottle drinking water

Day 01 ~ Pick up from City Hotel and proceed your journey to **Batang Ai**. The expedition will begin with a 3 hours car ride passing through the scenic greenery countryside. The vast land on both side of the road are can be seen dotted with vegetable farms, paddy fields, rubber, pepper oil palm and cocoa plantations which generated some of the top revenue earner crops of Sarawak. A brief lunch break will be at "Lachau" - small popular "cowboy" town for Indonesian natives from the nearby Kalimantan border town to do barter trade without the proper document. You could do your last minute shopping for the visiting gift to present to your Iban host. Arrive at Batang Ai Hydro Lake. The journey will take you across the lake into the Engkari River, one of the many tributaries flowing into the lake. The journey will take approximately 30 minutes before reaching the Longhouse nestled on a hill beside the river. The village of 30 to 40 "bilek" or rooms (each of one family) all under one roof built on stilts about a metre above the ground. Meet with its inhabitants and share a moment of their day. Share a glass of tuak (rice wine) and cultural performance with Iban hosts on the Ruai. Dinner & overnight at the longhouse.

Day 02 ~ After breakfast at the longhouse, proceed for a jungle walk. Picnic lunch at the riverbank. Afternoon, have short walk around the vicinity of the longhouse & observe the longhouse resident going about their daily life.

Day 03 ~ After breakfast at the guesthouse, you will be invited to watch the demonstration of one of the Iban favourite gambling game - 'cock fighting' and using of the blowpipe which will be held at the open space. That is a chance for you to try on this popular leisure game and polish your skill of using the deadly weapon - 'blowpipe'. Return trip to Kuching is by longboat and overland. Transfer back to Kuching and check in to hotel.
